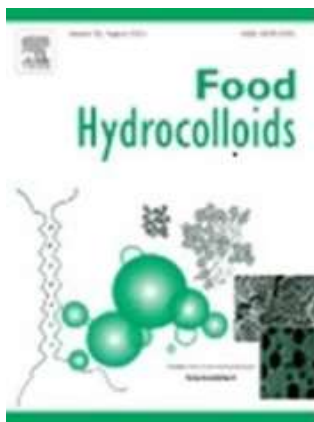
The deadline for submission of abstracts is July 31, 2022.

8. Polysaccharides and immune responses


